Post Mortem Room

:: Installation requirements

The post mortem room was in need of refurbishment and the existing vinyl was worn and due to insufficient falls in the substrate water was pooling, presenting a slip hazard. The hospital was looking for a hardwearing flooring solution that was hygienic and slip resistant under wet conditions. The project needed to be completed within tight timescales.

:: Why National Flooring?

Following a consultation, it was agreed that the existing floor finish had to be removed to allow National Flooring to create falls to the drains. The falls were formed using Degaflow 50/51, a quick curing screed that allowed the installation of the Degaflow FB system to be completed subsequently. Another option discussed was the installation of a polymer screed; however this would have required 3 days to cure before allowing the remainder of the installation to continue.

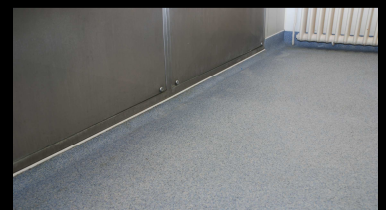
The Degaflow FB system is seamless and impervious, providing an extremely hygienic solution that leaves nowhere for bacteria to breed. The installation was complemented with a seamless covered skirting at 200mm installed to the white rock walling, helping to maintain a more sterile environment. The system not only offers outstanding slip resistance but also exceptional durability to withstand the frequent cleaning regimes.

National Flooring worked closely with the hospital and the builders working on the refurbishment to complete the installation with minimal disruption. The whole installation took just 2 days.
